Beyond Survival attends many community events throughout the year and often partners with other agencies to bring awareness within our community, in hopes to do our part to end sexual abuse.

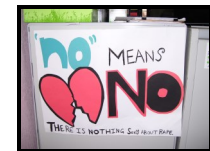
Prevention & Education

Prevention-

The goal in Washington State is to change norms, values, beliefs, and attitudes that contribute to sexual assault and shift ownership of the solution to the community.

How this is carried out-

- By partnering with Grays Harbor schools and by providing age appropriate presentations.
- Holding Parent/Teacher education nights and meetings.
- Working with schools to update policies on sexual harassment and abuse.
- Implementation of student digital story telling projects.



Parents C.R.E.A.T.E.

A class for parents and caregivers focusing on preventing child sexual abuse. This is a free four week course. Class Topics include:
